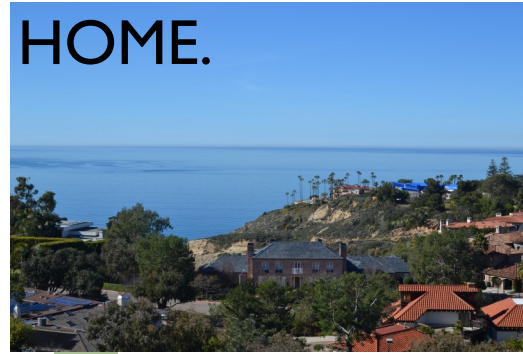
Celebrating the Independent Spirit
